**SCHEDULE "A"**

**SCHEDULE OF DOCUMENTS**

**I. Definitions**

For the purposes of this Schedule, the term "documents" includes all written, typed and printed matter, however produced or reproduced, including originals, all drafts, exhibits attached thereto, and duplicate originals, carbons and other copies thereof, in your possession, custody or control.

For the purposes of this Schedule, the term "interest" includes any interest of the judgment debtor whether it be legal or equitable, as obligor or obligee, and whether, such interest be sole, in joint tenancy, in tenancy-in-common, or otherwise.

**II. Documents to be Produced**

All documents, (including, but not limited to, books, records, certificates of ownership, contracts, deeds, financial statements, cancelled checks, loan applications, loans, security agreements, invoices, bills receipts, note, deposit slips, memorandums, trust agreements, United States Income Tax Returns (Form 1040) and amendments, for the past five years, pertaining to, evidencing, recording, representing, and/or containing information about an interest of the judgment debtor in savings accounts, checking accounts, deposits, notes, commercial paper, stocks, bonds, corporations, mortgages, real estates, trusts, safe deposit boxes, accounts receivable, insurance, automobiles, boats, trucks, jewelry, antiques, stamp or coin collections, other personal property and judgments, and any documents concerning any dealings either personal or financial with the above named judgment debtor.

1. Itemization of all bank books pertaining to accounts and savings accounts, in your name, or your name with others that have any relationship with you and the judgment debtor .
2. A list of all real estate owned or in which you possess a beneficial interest together with copies of deeds and/or trust agreements.
3. Any and all records pertaining to monies you have received during the past three years from any source, including wages, salaries, compensation for services, or payments or benefits of any kind.
4. A list of all your fixed obligations, including car payments, furniture payments, payments on appliances, and the like, giving names of creditors, amounts unpaid, and cancelled checks, if any, of all such payments for the past three years.
5. List of all stock and all other items tangible and intangible personal property which you own in your own name or with others or in which you have beneficial interest.
