SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT

INCIDENT:

SEXUAL ASSAULT

SUBJECT: WILLIAMS, GABRIEL

ADDRESS:

NARRATIVE:

On 6-28-02 I was working as an investigator of the San Jose Police Department Sexual Assaults Unit. I was assigned to the above case to conduct a victim interview.

CASE UPDATE:

On 7-11-02 at approximately 1300 hours, I met with the victim at the San Jose Police Department to conduct an interview. The interview was conducted in SAIU and was audio-recorded with the victim's knowledge. The audiocassette is available for review in SAIU.

STATEMENT OF VICTIM:

I reviewed the original report with the victim. She said it was accurate. I told the victim that I would like to go into more detail about each incident and her position she held at The Church of Scientology.

The victim said the church was located in Mountain View. She said that she first began working at the church approximately 3 years ago as a receptionist. After a year in that position the victim began a study program with the church in which she would learn information that eventually she would teach to other people. The victim said that during this time, Marc Grotkopf, Hank Vanbeeran, and the suspect were her supervisors. These three people reported to Dave Morris.

The victim said that eventually she became a supervisor. In Aug. 2000, Bret Coda (Flag Representative) told the victim that the international management of the Church of Scientology ordered her to start coming in at 0900 hours until 2100 hours. She was told that she would carpool with the suspect into work each day. The victim was told that she would stay over at the suspect's house so they could carpool together. The victim said her house was out of the way and therefore, it was more convenient to stay at the suspect's house. The suspect would drive her to and from work each day during the week and then she would return home to her family on the weekends.

The victim said her parents did not like the idea of the victim staying over at the suspect's house during the week, but they allowed her to do so. The victim said she has stayed over at other supervisor's houses and never had a problem before. The victim said she has stayed over at Angelina Diaz's and Vince S.'s house before without problems.
