Statement Continued:

I asked the victim if she worked under the suspect and she said yes. I asked the victim how did she become in contact with the suspect. The victim said that she was at the church and a person who held the position as a flag representative gave her an order to come in the mornings with the suspect. The victim described the function of the flag representative, which included giving orders to members.

The victim said ordered victims did about the order

The victim said that her dad did not like the order but said yes to the order. The victim said that particular night she went to the suspect's house and that is when it happened. I then reviewed the victim's statement with her. The victim said the order was approximately [redacted]. The victim advised me who the flag representative was and gave the subject's name. The victim described where the flag representative came from and why he was there. I asked the victim how long was the flag representative at the church when he gave that order? The victim said not more than a year. I asked the victim would it be fair to say about three to four months? The victim said yes. The victim could not give me an exact date. I then reviewed the victim's statement.

I asked the victim how she felt about the order that was given to her? The victim said she did not like it at all? I asked her why? The victim said she did not like to go to other people's house that she did not know. I asked the victim what was the exact order? The victim said that she was ordered to stay at the suspect's house from about 0900-2100 hours. I reviewed the victim's statement with her.

I advised the victim she was given the order, she did not like it but she agreed to it. The victim said she really did not like it and then explained that the order came from higher up in management. I asked the victim what would happen if she said no to the order? The victim said she would be in trouble. I asked her what she meant trouble and she started talking about ethics and conditions. The victim said that they would make her clean and that if she did not do it, it would effect everybody else. I asked the victim to correct me if I was wrong but if she did not follow what they said, she would be disciplined? The victim said that was a good word for it. I again advised the victim to correct me if I was wrong and I asked the victim she did not want to be disciplined so that is why she followed the order? I asked the victim yes or no? The victim said yes. The victim said before the order her dad would drop her off at the church and her mother would pick her up. The victim said she had been ordered in the past by a different flag representative to stay at other subject's homes. The victim said she was ordered two times prior to stay at other subject's homes. The victim said that nothing ever happened to her physically at the other homes. The victim said that the people she stayed with held higher positions than her and if she did something wrong the subjects would report it to the church.
